ORDER

As per order read as 1st above, Kerala State Electricity Regulatory Commission had revised tariff structure for the public EV charging stations.

As per ref 2nd cited, Ministry of Power, Govt. of India had issued detailed guidelines regarding the ceiling of service charges to be collected from public EV charging stations during solar and non-solar hours. The maximum service charges to be collected from public EV

charging station is as below.

Sl.No	Charging type	During solar hours (9AM – 4PM)	During non-solar hours (4PM – 9AM)
1.	AC (Slow)	Rs.3 / kWh	Rs.4 / kWh
2.	DC (Fast)	Rs.11 / kWh	Rs.13 / kWh

Presently ANERT have collected Rs.13 / kWh from the EV customers including service charges as flat rate.

As per orders of Kerala State Electricity Regulatory Commission electricity tariff during solar hours is Rs.5.50 (incl. 10% duty) and Rs.10.23 (incl. 10% duty) during non solar hours and as per Ministry of Power guidelines the service charges mentioned is the up limit. So we have to consider only the increase of electricity tariff from solar hours to non-solar hours for the revision of charging fee.

In the above circumstances, the revised charging fee is applicable to public EV charging stations of ANERT during solar hours and non solar hours is as follows:
